Jr Chef Central Shortened Day Program

Jr. Chef Central will provide a series of 5 hands-on cooking classes. Each 1 hour and 15 minute assembly is designed to build the knowledge, confidence and skills of participants, and facilitated by a cooking instructor. Each session will focus on increasing consumption of fresh fruits and vegetables, recipe preparation and proper use of relevant culinary tools and equipment.

During each session, one healthy dish will be prepared with an emphasis on the use of fresh seasonal produce. ALL new recipes for the assemblies this year are: Chicken Apple Wrap, Mediterranean Chicken Pita, Rainbow Tostada, Sloppy Turkey Joes, Skillet Roasted Strawberry-Banana Oatmeal.
